Each session will take place in some specific future, with presenters speaking from the perspective of someone working in that year, describing "current" challenges, innovations, and museum practices. Instructions

Each session must be:

- Set in a particular year (e.g., 2040, 2100)
- Reflect a specific vision of the future
- Explore how particular issues have played out in this future (Who is visiting museums and how? What technologies dominate the museum experience? What does it mean to BE a museum in that future?)
- Presented in an immersive manner (with panelists playing the roles of people living and working in that future, rather than saying "in the year 2040 museums will be like this.")
